A DAY TO SALUTE VETERANS

Veterans' Day - November 11th

Veterans' Day got its start over 80 years ago, at 11 a.m., on November 11, 1921, when an unidentified soldier from World War I was buried, in Virginia, at Arlington National Cemetery.

The service took place on the 11th hour, of the 11th day of the 11th month to recognize the end of World War I, which ended on that day and time in 1918.

It was known as Armistice Day, in honor of the "armistice", or end of fighting of World War I.

In 1954, President Dwight Eisenhower, signed a bill that officially proclaimed November 11th as Veterans' Day.

It is the VETERAN, not the reporter, who has given us freedom of the press.

who has given us freedom of speech.

Who has given us the right to vote.



The closing of Camp Curtin. happened on November 11 1865. Much later on November 11, 1990, at the 125th Anniversary of the closing of the camp, I portrayed War Governor for the first time: it's been 30 years now and I have been proud to act as Andrew Curtin. It was also the beginning of Camp Curtin Historical Society and Round Table.




