Our PA department won 2 awards for greatest gain of new brothers and the greatest number of new brothers under age 40. Pennsylvania Commander and SVC, Brothers Bill and Mike were

presented with new charters for camp 276 and 505.

was presented with Meritorious Service Award with Gold Star for excellence of service to the National Organization while assigned to National

Headquarters since 2008 at Harrisburg. The award was presented by CinC Peter Hritsko.

The Great Archie Griffin 2x Heisman Winner and Four-time Consecutive Rose Bowl Starter Statue Unveiled and Dedicated 17 Aug 2024 Pasadena, CA. <u>America250</u> History

Rose Bowl Stadium's Court of Champions, Griffin's statue is adjacent to the Archie Griffin Legacy Walk, which honors the 19 Heisman Trophy winners who have played in the Rose Bowl Game.

Griffin was awarded college football's Heisman



Trophy in 1974 and 1975 for OSU. The statue's unveiling marks the 50-year anniversary of his first Heisman Trophy in the upcoming 2024 college football season.

"There's just something magical when you play here in the Rose Bowl," said Griffin, who along

with family, friends and local leaders were there to see the christened. "Especially when it's played on New Year's Day, and the sun sets behind the mountains."

"Archie Griffin is part of the fabric of our historic venue for so many reasons, and I can't think of a more appropriate person to sit amongst the center of our new historic Legacy Walk," said Rose Bowl CEO and General Manager Jens Weiden, in a press release. Griffin's statue is the fifth to be added to the Rose Bowl stadium property, joining Jackie Robinson (2017), the 1999 Team USA FIFA Women's World Cup Champions (2019), sports broadcaster Keith Jackson (2019), and UCLA head coach Terry Donahue (2023)".




